SWIMMERS CODE OF CONDUCT

When registering with Golden Bay Swimming Inc. the swimmer/s and yourself are agreeing to the following Code Of Conduct

All Golden Bay Swimming Inc. Swimmers Are Expected To:

- Be respectful to and cooperate with Swim Instructors, Coaches and all others.
- Only be in the pool during your swimming session
- Be sun smart wear sunscreen and (when out of the pool) cover up, wear a hat, and stay in the shaded seating areas.
- Always consider the safety of others
- All Golden Bay Swimming Inc. swimmers and parents/caregivers must leave the pool area once the last session ends. After 6.15pm keyholder rules apply.
- Also follow the Golden Bay High School Pool Rules below (1-9):
 - 1. No Running
 - 2. No pushing/dunking/jumping/bombing in the pool
 - 3. No using the springboard unless instructed by your coach
 - 4. No unruly or dangerous behaviour anywhere in the water or around the pool.
 - 5. No food in and around the pool area.
 - 6. No glass in and around the pool area.
 - 7. No chewing gum in and around the pool area.
 - 8. No hanging out in the changing rooms.
 - 9. Rubbish must be taken home.

Adhere to Golden Bay Swimming Inc. Dress Code:

Swimwear:

- A one piece swimsuit and or swim shorts, swim rash top.
- Items are to be well fitting and are not to slip down or drag in the water

Goggles:

To be worn by ALL Golden Bay Swimming Inc. Swimmers at all levels, every session.

Swim Cap:

- Swimming Caps MUST be worn by ALL swimmers at all levels, every session.
- Golden Bay Swimming Inc. will provide a swimming cap at the start of the Swimming Season.
- If you lose your cap or forget your cap and need a replacement, you will be charged. Golden Bay Swimming Inc. Swimming replacement caps are \$10.00 each.

Non Compliance of Golden Bay Swimming Inc. Code of Conduct:

- Any Golden Bay Swimming Inc. swimmer not following the Golden Bay Swimming Inc. Code of Conduct will be given an initial warning.
- If non compliance of the Golden Bay Swimming Inc. Code of Conduct continues during the session; The swimmer will be told to leave the pool immediately and stay out of the pool for the remainder of the session.
- If non compliance of the Code of Conduct continues in a second session, the swimmer will be told to leave the pool immediately. Upon doing so, the swimmer's parent/caregiver will be informed.
- Again the swimmer must stay out of the pool for the remainder of the session.
- From there, in consultation with the swimmers parents/caregivers, the coach and/or a representative of the Golden Bay Swimming Inc. Committee, a decision will be reached as to the swimmers future attendance for the reminder of the Golden Bay Swimming Inc. Swimming Season.
